Itinerary

9.15 am

Meet with your Tour Manager and tour group at Downtown Ferry terminal Auckland City

9.30 am

Walk to Westhaven Marina to catch a private ferry and **cruise over Auckland Harbour** to 'Motuihe', an **uninhabited Island** in the Hauraki gulf. Here we learn about the **conservation efforts** to plant native trees on Motuihe island and restore the ecosystem. We then **help plant native tree saplings** on the island, cutting down invasive weeds and general planting and potting native species in the plant nursery.

12.30 pm

Lunch: Bring a packed lunch from home (there are no shops on the island!)

1.30 pm

After lunch, senior volunteers will take you on a **guided walk** on the island and point out some of the **native plants and birdlife**, before taking a **scenic ferry ride** returning to downtown Auckland.

*You will be provided with a certificate for the completion of a days volunteering.

4.30 pm

Return to downtown ferry terminal
