Auckland - Rotorua

Thursday 14 January Rotorua - Taupo

We say goodbye to Rotorua and travel south first to visit the opening of the Aratiatia Dam from here to Huka Falls, New Zealand's largest waterfall by volume. Friday 15 January Taupo - Tongariro National Park

This morning there is an opportunity to go Skydiving or taking a bungy jump over the magnificent Waikato River (at your own cost) we travel around the shores of Lake Taupo and arrive at the picturesque Tongariro National Park. We take a ride on the 'Sky Waka' Gondola up the North Island's highest mountain, Mount Ruapehu, for lunch up the top with stunning views all over the Central North Island. On the way down we take a short walk to view a beautiful waterfall before



checking into our accommodation. Relax here in the afternoon before enjoying a hearty dinner.
